2. Physical location training occurs:

3. Description of the training offered:

The Introduction to Electrical Career Pathways provides participants with an on-the-job training opportunity to work full-time as a Field Intern with an electrical contractor while taking weekly night classes on the basics of electricity and safety.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

Participants will receive a completion certificate and access to OSHA10, First Aid, CPR and more upon graduation.

5. Am I eligible?

Participants must be 18 years of age, have a drivers license and reliable transportation, a High School diploma or GED, be able to pass a drug test, and proficiency with the English language.
