3. Description of the training offered:

The Finishing Trades Institute of Maryland, Virginia, Washington D.C. and Vicinities provides nationally recognized training and certification in four separate Registered Apprenticeship programs within the IUPAT. Participants can choose to pursue careers as Commercial Painters, Bridge/Industrial Painters, Drywall Finishers, or Glaziers (Architectural Glass and Metal). All of our Registered Apprenticeship programs are structured as "earn while you learn" which means that participants will earn top tier wages and benefits as they learn on the job in conjunction with their class related study.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

OSHA 30, First Aid, CPR, Scaffold User, Swing Stage User, Mobile Elevated Work Platform Operator, NCCCO Operator, Confined Space Entry, Coating Applicator Specialist, Maryland Lead Abatement Worker, Architectural Glass and Metal Technician and various other nationally recognized credentials.

5. Am I eligible?

Applicants must be at least 17 years old.
Applicants must show proof of age.
Applicants must complete an Online Application.
Applicants must attend an Orientation Session.

6. What is the application process?

The Finishing Trades Institute of Maryland, Virginia, Washington D.C. and Vicinities requires applicants to complete an application on our website, which is online.ftimdvadc,edu, and attend an orientation session. Applicants must be a minimum of 17 years old and provide proof of age in the form of a State or Government Issued ID Card (license, passport, etc). Once applicants attend the Orientation Session they will become eligible for admission into apprenticeship.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Program completer's can expect to attain journeyworker Status and earn from \$60,000 to \$90,000 annually. All apprentices and journeyworkers receive a robust benefits package in addition to their annual salary. Benefits can include health care, pension and vacation.

8. How much do I have to pay for this program?

All of the Registered Apprenticeship programs provided by The Finishing Trades Institute of Maryland, Virginia, Washington D.C. and Vicinities are provided at no cost to the participant. All of our programs are free to the participant.
