



CONSTRUCTION/SKILLED TRADES

If you are looking for a career in Construction or a Skilled Trade the training below may be of interest to you.

1. Organization providing the training:

3. Description of the training offered:

The Apartment Maintenance Technician program at the Community College of Baltimore County spans six months and offers two certifications, Apartment Maintenance Technician (CAMT) certificate and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) certification. Participants engage in courses such as Safety Tools and Methods, Certified Apartment Maintenance Technician, Basic HVAC Electricity, and Intermediate HVACR, all designed to equip them with a strong foundation for entering the trade. These courses also serve as essential stepping stones for those looking to further their education and achieve HVAC certification.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

Earn your certified Apartment Maintenance Technician (CAMT) certificate and Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) certification.

5. Am I eligible?

REQUIREMENTS: 1.) High School Diploma/GED (preferred); 2.) TABE Assessment: Participants must obtain qualifying scores in reading and math. 3.) Six (6) month commitment to completing courses with reliable transportation/means of commuting to campus. 4.) Background Friendly

6. What is the application process?

All applicants are required to undergo an intake process. This involves a team member reaching out to gather demographic information from you. Typically, the intake lasts about 30 minutes and is conducted via phone. After the intake is finished, applicants will be added to the program's pending list.

Once an applicant completes the intake process, a team member will contact them to arrange their TABE Assessment. Should the applicant achieve the necessary qualifying scores, they will proceed to an interview that includes a background check. Upon successfully finishing the interview, the applicant will receive an offer to enroll in the course.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Starting wages in the State of Maryland for a Certified Apartment Maintenance Technician range from \$24-27 an hour.

8. How much do I have to pay for this program?

There are no upfront costs. Goodwill covers tuition, books and provides transportation assistance.
