3. Description of the training offered:

Living Classrooms Construction Skills program is a theory-based and hands-on training program designed to equip program participants with the essential skills, and practical experience, and safety protocol for an entry-level opportunity in the construction trade. The program combines classroom and real-world application covering two construction trades: Carpentry and Electrical.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

Trainees will receive an industry-recognized certification in OSHA 10 or OSHA 30.

5. Am I eligible?

The eligible candidate should be 18 years and older, a Baltimore City resident, and literacy/numeracy level of at least 5th grade.

6. What is the application process?

The application process is as follows:

- Attend an information session
- Complete a one-on-one intake with a case manager
- Once eligibility is determined, the program participant will begin classes

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Upon the completion of this training the expected wage upon completion is estimated to be \$17 per hour.

8. How much do I have to pay for this program?

There is no fee for this program.
