3. Description of the training offered:

A Maryland Corps UpLift Conservation Crew Member will be an essential part of the team in providing environmental and resiliency focused services such as the installation and maintenance of nature-based solutions such as conservation landscapes and rain gardens, performing maintenance of stream restoration sites, removing debris from waterways, engaging in disaster preparedness and response, and supporting community education and outreach. UpLift Crew Members work in teams under the direction of their Crew Leader, Landscape Foreman, and Operations Staff. UpLift Crew Members work successfully as a team to build and maintain environmental projects in Central MD as well as be exposed to a variety of career opportunities in the green infrastructure sector. This is a full-time position, Monday-Friday from 7am to 3:30pm. Weekend work opportunities may become available but are not mandatory.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

OSHA 10

American Red Cross First Aid CPR

Chesapeake Bay Landscape Professional Level A

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible, you must: be at least 18 years old by the program start date, commit to 40 hours/week, not be enrolled full-time in an education program, and have an interest in meeting new people, developing new professional skills, and discovering new possibilities for your career and/or educational journey.

6. What is the application process?

You MUST apply with BOTH Maryland Corps (Maryland Government) and EcoWorks. The 4-step process is detailed here: <https://www.howardecoworks.org/md-corps>.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

\$15/hour with a \$6,000 award received upon successful completion.

8. How much do I have to pay for this program?

The only cost associated with participation would be purchasing work boots if the participant does not have them.
