2. Physical location training occurs:

3. Description of the training offered:

Power52's Energy Professional Training Program is a 16-week hybrid program that combines live virtual instruction with hands-on learning. Classes take place Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM to 1:00 PM. Participants have the opportunity to earn nationally recognized certifications and gain the essential skills needed to launch a career in the renewable energy industry. In addition to technical training, the program also includes career readiness, financial literacy, homeownership preparation, entrepreneurial development, and ongoing mentorship from Power52 staff. All required personal protective equipment (PPE) is provided to support trainees in successfully completing the program.

4. Trainees have the opportunity to earn the following industry-recognized certifications:

5. Am I eligible?

To be eligible for this training program, applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be between the ages of 18-50 years old
- Have a High School Diploma or GED
- Be able to lift 50 pounds
- Demonstrate a commitment to trust the process and pursue a new career

6. What is the application process?

All applicants are required to complete a one-on-one interview with a Power52 staff member, take the TABE Assessment, and submit a completed enrollment application packet. Candidates who meet all eligibility cri-teria and demonstrate a clear understanding of the time commitment involved, along with a strong dedica-tion to building a new career, will be considered for acceptance into the program.

7. How much can I expect to earn if I complete this program and obtain employment?

Trainees who successfully complete the program and enter the workforce can expect to earn an average starting wage of approximately \$18.50 per hour. Compensation may vary based on additional skills, prior experience, and the specific employer.
