NOTICE OF HEARING

PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a hearing shall be held at the date, time, and location listed below to take evidence concerning the verified petition for review filed on behalf of a coalition of affiliates of the Laborers International Union (collectively "LIUNA") with the Maryland Commissioner of Labor and Industry, seeking review pursuant to §17-211 of the Maryland State Finance and Procurement Article of the following prevailing wage rates determined by the Commissioner under Section §17-209 for Laborer (Group II) in the Highway category for Anne Arundel, Baltimore, Carroll, Frederick, Harford, Howard, Montgomery, Prince George's and Queen Anne's counties as well as Baltimore City.

On December 26, 2024, the Washington Suburban Sanitary Commission ("WSSC") solicited for bid, a wage determination issued by the Prevailing Wage Unit (No. 60094) that included the Laborer (Group II) rate for Highway work in Montgomery County. Pursuant to §17-211(d) (2), the Commissioner will be holding a consolidated hearing addressing the petitions challenge to the rates for Laborer (Group II) for all ten of the above-referenced jurisdictions.

The hearing will be held on Wednesday January 15, 2025, beginning at 10:00 a.m., at the Division of Labor and Industry, 10946 Golden West Drive, Hunt Valley, Maryland 21031, and will continue day to day until completed.

The rules of procedure for the hearing can be found at COMAR 21.11.11.07. At the hearing, the Prevailing Wage Unit will introduce information that formed the basis of the wage determination. Any interested party may introduce other evidence that it feels is material to the wage determination.
